

**CITY OF FERGUSON, MISSOURI**  
**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

A Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday, September 23, 2025 at 7:00 PM in the Community Center Event Space, 1050 Smith Avenue, Ferguson, Missouri, at which time citizens may be heard on the property tax rates proposed by Ferguson, a political subdivision. The tax rates shall be set to produce the revenue which the budget for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, shows to be required from the property tax; and in accordance with the provisions of Section 137.115 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, and Article X, Section 22 of the Missouri State Constitution.
