**Traffic Commission Meeting Minutes**

The Ferguson Special Business District expressed the need for broader traffic control on Florissant Road;

FSBD discussed the implementation of traffic control measures that would not impede the commerce of the district;

Chairman Kasoff motioned for the Traffic Commission to support the engineering plan for traffic calming on the Florissant Road business district; Seconded by Ms. Fletcher; Six in favor; One abstain from Dr. Powell-Walker; **MOTION PASSED.**

Mr. Foushee gave a presentation on road signage and speeding deterrents;

The commission discussed the City of Ferguson's role in the upkeep of county roads and the cost thereof;

Councilwoman Lipka expressed the concerns of residents near Chambers Road, including the implementation of road barriers to create dead end streets;

Mr. Foushee asserted the effectiveness of speed limit signs and broader traffic law enforcement;

The commission discussed the implementation of street dips;

Chairman Kasoff requested the presence of Chief McCall at the next Traffic Commission meeting;

The commission discussed the county's plan for the implementation of a roundabout on Chambers Road;

Councilwoman Lipka stated that the council has not held a discussion on the budget for the implementation of a roundabout;

The commission discussed the usage of up-to-date technology for data collection for traffic calming purposes;

The commission discussed polling technology to gather data on citizen's opinions on traffic and speeding issues;

The commission discussed the logistics of the Traffic Control town hall slated for April 21<sup>st</sup> and April 23<sup>rd</sup> respectively;

#### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Erica Brooks expressed her support of the implementation of speed bumps and street divots on Florissant Road and other problem roads in the area;

Ms. Brooks asserted that proper signage would be necessary with the implementation of speed bumps;

#### **ADJOURMENT**

Chairman Kasoff adjourned the Ferguson Traffic Commission open session meeting at approximately 8:55PM.
