Topics:

1. Financial Report- Current Budget FY 2024-2025 remaining amount is \$12,008.50.
 - Discussed the current budget and how the FSBD Board can spend the funds before the fiscal year (July 1- June 30).
 - Assistant D. Musgrave explained the process for purchasing and invoice reconciling.
 - The City of Ferguson is tax exempt, therefore it is easier for FSB to have the vendor submit invoices to the City for payment.
 - We need to be sure the Vendor is on the City's Vendor list, if not we can get that added as a preferred vendor.
 - D. Musgrave also mentioned, FSBD can make purchases and then turn in the receipts on a reimbursable basis (a check will issued back to FSBD).
 - Has FSBD reached out to Sports Print for quotes regarding wearable apparel?

2. **Accomplishments to date:**

- Collected water and household supplies for the Tornado Relief on May 24-25th.

3. **New Business/ Proposal:**

- Proposed use of the budget- Adopted a new Logos for FSDB, waiting to hear back from Staff Liaison regarding concerns from Council. If no concerns, FSBD will proceed with the use of the Logo.
- Getting quotes for Billboards (and locations), Airplay and other forms of Marketing for FSBD.
- Confirmed the FSBD Open House, which will be held on June 26th from 5:30 PM-7:30 PM. At 313 S. Florissant Rd. Ferguson, MO 63135.
- Beatification of the FSBD Corridor- which includes additional lighting
- Work with Rodney at Soul Craft for marketing material to help support businesses.
- Prepare for the 2025-2026 Budget to present to Council.
- FSBD being a part of the next Juneteenth event.
- Discussion about Community Events, such as Street Fest, Northern Lights, Christmas Fests and a Toy Drive for upcoming Holidays. We also discussed handing out candy for Halloween.
- Support Drake's Place by being an active sponsor during Trivia Night (May 30). FSBD approved \$1,500.00.
- Discussed how North County Inc. and North County Chambers of Commerce could support FSBD.
- There were a few Households on Marvin that were affected by the May 16th tornado.
