Executive Order Number 2

Policies concerning operational adjustments, employee policies, access to facilities, and intentional gathering

Whereas, the St. Louis County Executive has declared a State of Emergency pertaining to all of St. Louis County;

Whereas, the Mayor of the City of Ferguson, Missouri, has declared a State of Emergency pertaining to all of the City of Ferguson;

Whereas, the St. Louis County Executive has issued Executive Orders 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 which are attached hereto and made a part of this Executive Order as exhibits A, B, C, D and E;

Whereas, the St. Louis County Department of Public Health has issued its Order on Gatherings which is attached hereto and made a part of this Executive Order as exhibit F;

Whereas, it is the intent of the City of Ferguson, Missouri, that this and all other Executive Orders of the Mayor of the City of Ferguson shall expire only upon future order or orders by the St. Louis County Executive, declaring that the State of Emergency no longer exist;

Now, Therefore, I James W. Knowles III, Mayor of the City of Ferguson, Missouri, do hereby declare and order the following:

1. The City affirms Executive Orders 11, 12, 13 and 14 of the St. Louis County Executive as pertaining to and is in effect for the City of Ferguson, Missouri.
2. The City affirms the St. Louis County Department of Public Health's Order on Gatherings as pertaining to and is in effect for the City of Ferguson, Missouri.
3. All places of public accommodation located in the City of Ferguson offering food and beverage services to the public shall display signage provided by the City at all points of entrance.
