**CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AUTHORITY**

114.00 PURPOSE

The purpose of this General Order is to establish the authority for the chief executive officer of the Ferguson Police Department. The chief executive officer for the Ferguson Police Department is determined by City of Ferguson Ordinances as the Chief of Police and designates that he has total authority and responsibility for the management, direction, and control of operations and administration of the agency.

114.01 AUTHORITY

- A. By the authority of the ordinances of the City of Ferguson “At the head of each department there shall be a director who shall have supervision, control and assignment of personnel in the department, subject to the authority of the city manager” (2-201).
- B. “The police department shall consist of a chief of police, and such inferior police officers as may be deemed necessary for the proper conduct of the duties of the department, ...” (33-16).
- C. “The chief of police shall have general supervision and control of the police department, including the enforcement of discipline among the members thereof and the instruction of the members in their duties.” (33-18).
