3. making payments (for fines and court costs) to the municipal court.

Please call (314) 524-5264, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, for the above information. At all other times, when calling about warrants/bonds, please call the Ferguson Police Department at (314) 522-3100.

The following persons shall not enter a municipal courthouse:

- Persons who have traveled to any foreign country within the last 14 days;
- Persons who have traveled to states designated as “restricted” by the St. Louis County Department of Health within the past 14 days. (For a current listing, see the St. Louis County Website: www.stlcorona.com. Then click the “Update Travel List” button under “Areas of Community Transmission” on the right-hand side of the page.);
- Persons who reside or have had close contact with someone who has traveled to any foreign country or restricted area in the U.S. within the last 14 days;
- Persons who have been asked to self-quarantine by any doctor, hospital or health agency;
- Persons who have been diagnosed with, or have had contact with, anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19; and
- Persons with unexplained fever, cough or shortness of breath.
