OCCUPANCY PERMIT AND INSPECTION

(lets get the boring stuff out of the way first)



Occupancy Permit and Inspection Process:

1. Apply (either in-person or online), the applicant needs to have a valid ID
2. Pay the occupancy inspection fee
3. Show proof of active trash service

If this is a rental property, you will also need:

1. ID for the owner
2. Owner authorization form
3. A current rental license

SUMMER CONCERT SERIES

FERGUSON MUNICIPAL PUBLIC LIBRARY

The Ferguson Municipal Public Library began in June 1930 as a volunteer community library. The library offers printing services, access to computers, wifi, and wifi hot-spots that can be checked out, as well as a huge collection of books for check out! The library is located at 35 North Florissant Rd. Ferguson, MO 63135 and is open Monday – Saturday.



FERGUSON COMMUNITY EMPOWERMENT CENTER

The Salvation Army and the Urban League of Metropolitan St. Louis partnered together to create the Ferguson Community Empowerment Center. This organization provides assistance, social services, and community programs. The Ferguson Community Empowerment Center is located at 9420 W. Florissant Avenue

FERGUSON COMMUNITY CENTER

The Ferguson Community Center is a beautiful building with state-of-the-art amenities. MEET OUR LEADERS



ELLA JONES

Mayor

Mayor Jones was elected in 2020 as the first woman and African American mayor of Ferguson. Mayor Jones is currently serving in her second term. The Mayor is elected at large and serves a three-year term. The mayor is a member of City Council and is responsible along with City Council for setting policies and passing ordinances that have the force of law.



JOHN HAMPTON

City Manager

The city manager is the chief executive and administrative officer of the City of Ferguson and is responsible to the City Council for the proper administration of the affairs of the city. In a council-manager government, the council essentially hires the city manager to run the day-to-day operations of the city. The current city manager is John Hampton, who also serves as the city's Fire Chief.

CITY COUNCIL

The City Council consists of six Council members and the Mayor. Two Council members are elected from each of the three wards, for three-year overlapping terms. The Mayor is elected at large and also serves a three-year term. As elected officials, they are responsible for setting policies for the City and passing ordinances that have the force of law.

Mayor Jones and the City Council lead council meetings, which are held at 7:00 p.m. on the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of each month, with exception. In April, meetings are held on the 3rd and 4th Tuesday, due to elections. In July and August, meetings are held on the 4th Tuesday.

Meetings are open to the public and are broadcast locally on the government access station on cable television. Meetings are also streamed live on the City of Ferguson's website and uploaded to YouTube at *Ferguson MO Govt TV*.
