Your guide to the

Police Complaint Process & the Ferguson Civilian Review Board

WHO ARE WE?

The Ferguson Civilian Review Board (FCRB) reviews all civilian complaints of misconduct by any member of the Ferguson Police Department (FPD). The Board also reviews police policies and procedures, makes recommendations on the disposition of civilian complaint cases, and provides information to the community on crime statistics and trends.



The nine (9) member Board is appointed by the Ferguson City Council and consists of two (2) residents from each of Ferguson's three (3) wards and three (3) at-large members who either work or have businesses in Ferguson.

WHO MAY FILE A COMPLAINT?

Anyone who believes they have experienced, witnessed, or represents a minor who has experienced misconduct by a member of the Ferguson Police Department (FPD).

HOW DO YOU FILE A COMPLAINT?

Complaints can be filed by completing an official complaint form. Forms may be found on the City of Ferguson website, crb@fergusoncity.com, at Ferguson City Hall, 110 Church Street, the Ferguson Police Department, 222 S Florissant Road or at the Ferguson Civilian Review Board meetings. The complaint form may be submitted at any of the above locations.



WHAT DOES THE FCRB DO AFTER A COMPLAINT IS FILED?

After the Ferguson Police Department completes its investigation, the FCRB reviews the complaint and Ferguson Police Department (FPD) findings/determinations. The FCRB may request additional information or further investigation before completing their review. The Board's independent recommendations are forwarded to the Ferguson Police Department (FPD). The person filing the complaint will be notified in writing of the final determination in the case. (See Flow Chart on back of brochure.)
